Currently my girls have gone to college or married. Sean is 11 years old now and his heart is still unstable and will be having more surgeries in the near future. As for me, my clientele continues to increase, which makes the stress with Sean's health not as unbearable. The ability to stay close to him and work is highly important for our well being.

The day I walked into Dave Shuster's office was virtually a miracle! I never in my wildest dreams thought I could own a home again.... EVER! Your organization is heaven sent and Dave made me feel so welcome and handled all the processing smoothly, even finding a first mortgage holder that would approve my loan.
